*Internship may be taken for 1-3 credits

Work at least 10-15 hours per week

Spend at least 50% of the time writing/writing related tasks

Use good critical reading, thinking, and writing skills

Develop career search materials

Attend regular meetings of the class or contact with faculty sponsor

ENGFLM 1930

*Internship may be taken for 1-3 credits

1 credit for +- 40 hours on site per term

2 credits for +-80 hours on site per term

3 credits for +-120 hours on site per term

(Academic work also varies by credits taken)

Attend regular meetings or contact with a faculty sponsor

ENGLIT 1907

*Internship may be taken for 1-3 credits

Work at least 10-15 hours per week

Use good critical reading, thinking, and organizational skills
