PHILIP METRES IS PROFESSOR OF ENGLISH AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE PEACE, JUSTICE, AND HUMAN RIGHTS PROGRAM AT JOHN CARROLL UNIVERSITY IN CLEVELAND. HE IS THE AUTHOR OF *BEHIND THE LINES: WAR RESISTANCE POETRY ON THE AMERICAN HOMEFRONT SINCE 1941* (UNIVERSITY OF IOWA 2007) AND CO-EDITOR OF *COME TOGETHER: IMAGINE PEACE: AN ANTHOLOGY OF PEACE POEMS* (BOTTOM DOG 2008). HE HAS ALSO PUBLISHED AND TRANSLATED SEVERAL BOOKS OF POETRY, MOST RECENTLY *PICTURES AT AN EXHIBITION* (UNIVERSITY OF AKRON 2016), *SAND OPERA* (ALICE JAMES 2015), *I BURNED AT THE FEAST: SELECTED POEMS OF ARSENY TARKOVSKY* (CLEVELAND STATE POETRY CENTER 2015), *COMPLEAT CATALOGUE OF COMEDIC NOVELTIES: POETIC TEXTS OF LEV RUBINSTEIN* (UGLY DUCKLING PRESSE 2014), AND *A CONCORDANCE OF LEAVES* (DIODE 2013).
