The Pittsburgh Business Times is looking for an energetic and dynamic reporting intern with a demonstrated aptitude for writing news stories. This paid, full-time internship will run for 10 weeks during the summer.

Successful candidates will have a portfolio of work demonstrating proficiency for news writing, strong communication skills, command of AP style and preferably an interest in business journalism as a career. Candidates should also have experience working with social media and multimedia.

What you can expect:

- To work in a reporting position and leave the internship with published print clips, including a more in-depth capstone project
- To report directly to an editor who will supply regular feedback and evaluations
- To meet regularly with a staff mentor who will serve as an informal writing and reporting coach
- To have opportunities to attend special events and networking functions where you can meet local business community leaders
- To gain connections with not only Pittsburgh Business Times staff members, but also others at American City Business Journals, which has business publications throughout the country

This internship position pays \$15 an hour, funded by a Pitt English Department Internship Grant.

In order to receive funding, you must fit these eligibility requirements:

- Must be an English major (including DNID), minor, or certificate student, including PPW, Children's Literature, Public Communication of Science and Technology, and Disability Studies.
- Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
