## **UNIVERSITY TEACHING EXPERIENCE**

### **Carnegie Mellon University**

#### Undergraduate Course

#### 76-101 – Interpretation and Argument

An inquiry-driven writing course for first-year students focused on Becoming and Unbecoming Ourselves Online. Assignments include a Comparative Genre Analysis, a Proposal Essay, and a Contribution Essay. Students learn methods for creating an original research question, creating surveys, compiling data, and writing an original, synthesized contribution essay.

### **Point Park University**

#### Graduate Courses

#### EDUC604 - Practicum in K-12 Schools in Learning, Design, and Technology

The final course in the fully online M.Ed. in Learning, Design and Technology asynchronous program. Students engage in discussion boards, online activities aligned to K-12 Pennsylvania Department of Education standards, 60 hours of fieldwork, and an online portfolio focused on instructional technology concepts learned.

#### EDUC603 - Field Work in K-12 Schools in Learning, Design, and Technology

Practicum to assist graduate students in gaining experience teaching in an online K-12 environment. Assignments in this course include discussion boards, online activities aligned to K-12 Pennsylvania Department of Education standards, 60 hours of fieldwork, and an online portfolio focused on online teaching experiences.

#### EDUC539 - Research in Learning, Design and Technology

Part of the fully online M.Ed. in Learning, Design, and Technology asynchronous program. This graduate course requires students to conduct in-depth research regarding online learning, instructional design, and instructional technology administration and management. Students engage in discussions, collaborative learning activities, and the creation of research projects related to online learning strategies.

#### Undergraduate Courses

#### **ENGL101 – College Composition**

This undergraduate course exposes students to the best theories regarding argumentative writing, researching, and analyzing. Students sharpen writing and close reading skills through collaborative and independent assignments.

#### ENGL147 – Writing Studio

This undergraduate course provides supplemental support for first-year writing students.

#### **Undergraduate** Courses

#### **ENGCMP 0200 - Seminar in Composition**

An undergraduate seminar course focused on increasing student writing levels and close reading skills. Small class size enables students and the professor to collaborate and learn through various activities, including small group discussion, in-class writing, and peer reviews.

#### ENGCMP 0210 - Seminar in Composition – Engineering

An undergraduate seminar course in which students hone writing skills through various assignments focused on engineering ethics, disciplines, and practices used in the industry. Member of the in-class teaching team since August 2023.

#### **ENGCMP 0400 – Written Professional Communication**

Part of the Public and Professional Writing Certificate Program, students create an array of documents found in various workplaces while also learning ways to communicate professionally.

#### **ENGCMP 0412 – Engineering Communication in a Professional Context**

Students use writing and formatting skills learned in Seminar in Composition – Engineering to collaborate in groups to create a research paper, poster, and proposal featured at the First Year Engineering Conference. Member of the in-class teaching team since August 2023.

#### ENGCMP 1112 - Professional Uses of Social Media

Part of the Public and Professional Writing Certificate Program, this undergraduate course focuses on using Social Media platforms for professional opportunities and communication. Assignments include a HubSpot Social Media Marketing Certificate, a social media campaign research proposal, and a final presentation.

### **Butler County Community College**

#### **Undergraduate** Courses

#### ENGL031- Reading, Writing, Reasoning

This course focuses on providing students with additional tools used to increase close reading and academic writing skills. Scaffolding is used to engage students in activities and learning assessments.

#### **ENGL101 - College Writing**

This course introduces students to the writing and revision process of multi-paragraph essays. Students learn MLA and APA formatting, as well as methods for stronger academic writing.

#### **ENGL102 - Research Writing**

Students increase their writing and research skills through a variety of essays while strengthening persuasion, evaluation, and formatting skills.

#### **ENGL110 - Technical Writing I**

This course provides students with opportunities to increase their oral and written communication skills used in the workplace. Students create a variety of letters, memos, job application materials, and oral presentations while also learning the uses of electronic and visual communication.

This course provides students with the tools needed to execute college-level writing assignments. Focus is placed on sentence and paragraph flow as well as multi-paragraph essays.
